We all make mistakes.... and they can be fixed! Learn to use a variety of lifting brushes, sandpaper, melamine sponge and dental tweezers to make those mistakes disappear! Useful tips for lifting highlights and veins will also be given.

Please bring a painting with mistakes that you wish to fix!

Supply List:

- Hot pressed paper (i.e. 7" x 10" or 9" x 12" Arches) – 3 sheets
- H graphite pencil (I like Staedtler Mars)
- Click Eraser Stick – Paper Mate Tuff Stuff
- 400 grit blond sandpaper (1/4 sheet)
- Mr. Clean Magic Eraser Original (1/4 sponge)
- Scissors
- Locking dental tweezers, if you have them. Catherine will have locking dental tweezers for sale (\$8 each).

- Brushes for lifting paint:
 - Princeton Art & Brush Co. 6300B, #2 Bright
 - Robert Simmons Expression E60 Flat Shader #2 & #4

- Your regular sable paintbrushes

- Bring your watercolor paints used for the painting with mistakes that you wish to fix

- Small battery operated LED task light (important). There are a variety of lightweight battery operated LED appropriate for our work. A list of suggestions will be posted online over the summer. Also, consider using long-life rechargeable batteries. Note: power will not be available for corded lights.

- Magnifying glass (important too!)
