Explore the historical medium of egg tempera while painting miniatures. Using egg tempera from a tube – no mixing of yolk, water & pigment – work on gessoed panels and ivorine. Learn the mixing and layering techniques of egg tempera to create a luminescent miniature painting of our beautiful New England fall leaves, gourds and acorns.

Supply List:

Kolinsky sable brushes: your choice of 2 brushes in size range 00 - 2

Your usual drawing and transferring materials:

Drawing paper & tracing paper
size = 9 x12 – 2-3 sheets of each

Pencils—HB and 2H for drawing; 2B creating carbon on back of tracing paper.

Small battery operated LED task light. There are a variety of lightweight battery operated LED appropriate for our work. A list of suggestions will be posted online over the summer. Also, consider using long-life rechargeable batteries. Note: power will not be available for corded lights.
