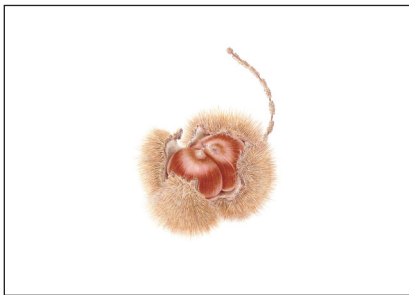

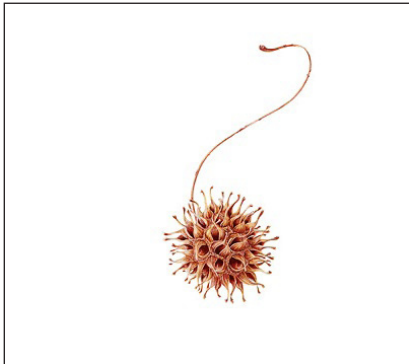

Learn a technique for achieving the intricacies of fine detail in your paintings. Properly protecting those critical edges in your drawing before laying down your watercolor washes is an invaluable process for contemporary botanical artists. As a result, your paintings will be brought to a new level of realism and detail. Students should have skills in drawing and watercolor.

Watercolor Pigments, 5ml tubes
Windsor & Newton: Quinacridone red
Schmincke; Vanadium yellow, Cerulean blue tone, Brilliant Blue Violet
Daniel Smith: Quinacridone gold

Brushes, (if possible to locate or equivalent)
Pro Arte Series 107 Spotters Gold handled Spotter brushes sizes 02 & 04.

Paper
2 quarter sheets - approximately 11" x 14" each - of Arches of 300gsm smooth hot press watercolor paper
1 sheet - A4 or letter sized - architects' acetate, Mylar, or tracing paper

Several sheets in a small sketch pad
Pencils, HB, 2B & 4H graphite pencils

Masking Fluid, Windsor & Newton Masking Fluid; (please note if your masking fluid is more than 9 months old please purchase a new bottle)

Calligraphers nib
Hunt Globe 861 with nib holder. (John can supply a few with prior arrangement)

Optional: Small battery operated LED task light. Also, consider using long-life rechargeable batteries. Note: power will not be available for corded lights.
